

ADMISSION GUIDELINES & PROCESS

The **International Holistic Guidance & Research Centre (IHGRC)** welcomes students with mild to moderate disabilities to participate in the kind of unique holistic program we offer. The integration of traditional academics, life skills vocational training through physical, psychological, social, intellectual, cultural and educational aspects through multidisciplinary intrusion approach for the holistic development of the children. our services aim to maximize each child's potential through individualized, goal-oriented and mostly developmentally sequenced program to deliver child-focused psycho-social skills fortification based on ABA (Applied Behavioral Analysis) principles.

Step I: Conduct the proper assessment and identify the disorder.

Step II: Assessment from Holistic Guidance Centre: Behavioral assessment and Special needs care assessment.

Step III: Admission: Submit the relevant documents*and pay monthly fees according to the session plan.

*DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Assessment Report from the specialist psychiatrist with concluded diagnosis (as per DSM-IV classification) through various assessments.
2. Emirates ID copy of child and father.
3. Passport and Visa copy of the child and father.
4. Address proof of UAE residence (SEWA copy or telephone bill)
5. One passport size photograph.

PROGRAM FORMULATION AND IMPLEMENTATION

- After the admission, based on the concluded diagnosis (as per the DSM-IV classification of disorder) an IEP (Individualized Education Program) will be prepared within one week after the admission (based on the assessment report and observation).
- The multi-disciplinary intervention team members are involved in the program. The psychologist, mental health counselor, special educator, skill development trainer, art teacher, yoga therapist and physical educator are also involved according to the needs of the child.
- The weekly intervention plan and feedback is updated in the student's diary so that the lessons and strategies applied in the centre can also be worked upon during the weekend.

Regular session: 1st Batch: 10:00 am to 01:00 pm (Sunday to Thursday)

2nd Batch: 11:00 am to 02:30 pm (Sunday to Thursday)

After school session: 3rd Batch: 04:00 pm to 06:00 pm (Sunday to Thursday)

Weekend session: Every Saturday according to the intervention nature
